*Academic Achievement Discount

Who qualifies for the Academic Achievement Discount?

A special Academic Achievement Discount of 10% applied to the premiums charged for liability, medical payments, personal injury protection and collision coverage may be given to all Rate Class 2 drivers (including Farm rated policies), subject to the following provisions:

1. Is under 25 years of age and qualifies as a youthful driver under the Texas Department of Insurance automobile classification plan (Class "2" driver).
2. Is enrolled as a full-time student in:
 - a. The junior or senior year of high school; or
 - b. Academic courses in an institution of higher education (college or university).
3. According to the official scholastic records for the preceding academic semester, quarter, or other grade reporting period, has:
 - a. A "B" average or better; or
 - b. A 3.0 average or better on a 4.0 scale.
4. Is licensed to drive in the state of Texas.
